PRIORITIZE THE TOP 10 USER STORIES

Start with the highest-priority stories from your backlog. Make sure to prioritize the ones that will deliver the most value.

02

ESTIMATE EFFORT WITH YOUR DEV TEAM

Sit down with your dev team (and maybe designers, if needed) and assign effort points to each story. Use whatever scale your team prefers (Fibonacci, t-shirt sizes, etc.)

DEFINE YOUR SPRINT CAPACITY

03

Ask your team how many story points they can handle in the sprint.

This is your sprint's capacity (i.e. Velocity).

BUILD YOUR SPRINT BACKLOG

04

Take the tickets that fit within your team's capacity and add them to the sprint backlog. Now you're ready to start!
